FROM THE DESK OF FR. KAMIL OUR LADY OF FATIMA

It was the spring of 1917. On many fronts there was still the First World War. Meanwhile, in Fatima, in a small unknown town in the heart of Portugal, in Cova da Iria ("Valley of Peace"), on May 13 three children experienced a great miracle – apparition of the Blessed Virgin. No one could have expected that the message from the Beautiful Lady, which was conveyed during six apparitions to a 10-year-old Lucia, 9-year-old Francis and 7-year-old Jacinta, would move the whole world. "The Miracle of the Sun" which took place on October 13, 1917 and was witnessed by thousands of thousands was a tangible sign that what had happened on every thirteenth day of a month had had divine origin.

That day, October 13, 1917, Our Lady appeared to the children the last time. While conversing with them She revealed her name: *"I am the Mother of the Rosary"*. Our Lady of Fatima asked all people to pray the rosary and to build a chapel dedicated to her in the place of the apparitions. She asked the children: "Pray for the endangered world, fly to my Immaculate Heart and repent."

This message given to us by Mary is an urgent call for conversion. If we want to experience God's graces and mercy, we have to get to the point of transformation. Furthermore, we have to trust God's providence just like Mary did. She is a perfect example of what it means to be a faithful servant of the Lord.

It is Her, the Mother of the Son of God, who with infinite compassion intercedes for all of us in the most difficult and sorrowful moments in our lives. It is in Her loving arms that we find peace, hope and security. Having said *"fiat"* - *"let it be done to me"*, Mary teaches us all how to accept and fulfill the will of God in our daily lives, the will that leads us to the joys of heaven.

Last Saturday, May 13, 2017 with the entire Catholic Church we celebrated the 100th anniversary of Her apparitions in Fatima. We knelt before our Blessed Mother and recited the Act of Consecration to Her Immaculate Heart.

Let us pray often to God through Her powerful intercession repeating:

"O Most Holy Virgin Mary, Queen of the most holy Rosary, you were pleased to appear to the children of Fatima and reveal a glorious message. We implore you, inspire in our hearts a fervent love for the recitation of the Rosary. By meditating on the mysteries of the redemption that are recalled therein may we obtain the graces and virtues that we ask, through the merits of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Redeemer."

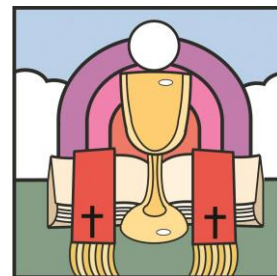
