Come Holy Spirit! Fill the hearts of the faithful!

Today we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost. We hear Jesus breathe on us, "Receive the Holy Spirit." We recall Jesus' promise, "Peace I leave with you. My peace I give to you." Do we believe? 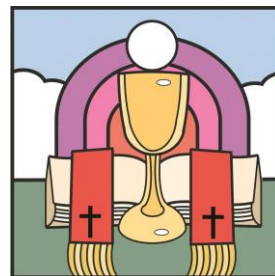

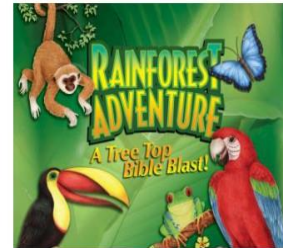
